

NAMED GIFTS AND SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



Maloto is delighted to provide the following opportunities to donors who wish to restrict their gifts of \$2,500 or more to a particular program or activity that resonates with their philanthropic goals. Donors will be recognized in our publications and on our website, and donors may also choose to remain anonymous. Sponsorship opportunities can bear your name or the name of a loved one. Following are annual and multi-year giving opportunities that can be paid in full or pledged to pay over time.

\$2,500

Fund the salaries for the after-school tutors for an entire school year to educate 265 children.

Provide a one-year scholarship to university in Malawi.

\$5,000

Create a named scholarship fund to cover the cost of a student attending Mzuzu International Academy.

Provide the salary of an Early Childhood Education teacher for one year.

Underwrite the cost of purchasing a van for use by our HIV/AIDS outreach teams, supplementing the bicycles currently used by these volunteers.

Cover the costs of providing professional development and training for our teachers.

Outfit our Mzuzu International Academy sports teams with new equipment for five years.

\$6,500

Provide a one-year secondary school scholarship for a vulnerable child.

\$7,500

Fund our student filmmaking program, allowing students to express themselves and to tell their own stories.



\$8,000

Cover the fees for five primary school-aged children to attend school for one year including room, board and tuition.

\$10,000

Provide hot meals to feed 350 children three times a week.

Create a named scholarship fund to cover the costs of a 4-year university education for Kwithu students graduating from Mzuzu International Academy.

Create an employee micro loan fund to help staff pay larger one-time or emergency personal expenses.

Underwrite the cost of building an additional classroom for our Early Childhood Development program, so that we can educate an additional 20 students annually.

\$20,000

Provide the annual salaries for four teachers, covering a full year of instruction for our Early Childhood Education students at Kwithu CBO.

Cover the cost of one generator to ensure uninterrupted electricity in the Mzuzu International Academy classrooms or Kwithu Kitchen.

Provide one year's wages for 16 women working in the Kwithu Kitchen Women's Cooperative tomato canning business.

Underwrite the cost of an industrial-sized soup kettle to prepare our new tomato products.

\$25,000

Provide a 4-year secondary school scholarship to ensure a vulnerable child can attend and graduate from high school.

\$30,000

Underwrite our Early Childhood Development program for one year and help educate 40 students.

\$33,000

Sponsor a child's education from early childhood development through high school graduation

\$50,000

Cover the costs of building two additional ECD classrooms and salaries for two more teachers so we may serve an additional 40 children.
