


### MISSION

# LETTER FROM OUR FOUNDER

Dear Friends,

Like many of you, we never imagined Covid would still be a challenge almost two years later. First and foremost, I want to send my heartfelt wishes that you and your loved ones are well.

While Omicron struck Malawi along with the rest of the world, thankfully cases were much less severe among our community. The majority of our staff have been vaccinated, which is a gift in the developing world where many have struggled to gain access to the vaccines.

Despite these challenging times, we have much good news to share with you across all three of our programs. At **Kwithu CBO** we are directly helping 324 vulnerable children (up from 20 in 2004) and over 150 women. At **Mzuzu International Academy**, we now have almost 400 students (up from 35 in 2010). **Kwithu Kitchen** is buying honey directly from more than 500 beekeepers. These three programs cumulatively are employing more than 200 people. And that's not all:

- Eight Kwithu Scholarship students graduated college over the summer, bringing the total number of Kwithu Scholarship college graduates to 17. I feel this is such an important marker of success.
- Kwithu Kitchen's sales, driven by honey, continue to boom. Year-over-year honey sales are up 44%. Last fiscal year, Kwithu Kitchen's sales topped \$250,000, and we have an aggressive sales target of \$325,000 for this fiscal year.

Lastly, we are thrilled to finally be moving full steam ahead with our **GALA** in **New York on May 12, 2022**. Despite the recent Omicron developments, we remain optimistic that many of our friends and supporters will look forward to gathering together in the spring. While the world has changed, we do know that the power of in-person connection is hard to replace. We are excited to engage with our existing supporters and broaden our circle to bring new friends to our cause.

As always, please accept my continued and heart-felt expressions of gratitude for all that you do for Maloto.

# **EMPOWER**

- Kwithu is now supporting 4 women's groups with various income-generating activities, including financial literacy training to improve the outcome for financial sustainability.
- •Following its launch in 2020, Kwithu Kitchen (KK) Honey has not only become Malawi's largest supplier of honey, KK sales grew by 44% over the same period in 2021.
- •Kwithu Kitchen has been developing several new products in 2021, including mango & tomato jams, ketchup, hot chili sauce and dried mango chips.
- •KK has received a grant from the Gov of Flanders to work with over 30 beekeeping clubs to increase their honey production from 3 to 15 tons over a 3-year period. This will substantially increase their incomes and provide KK with a reliable source of high-quality honey.


